

Boarding School Fees

Secondary School and IB Diploma Programme

Our boarding school fees cover most of the costs associated with attending the International School of Schaffhausen as a boarding school student enrolled in the IB Programme, Pre-IB Programme, or the US High School Diploma Programme. These fees include classroom instruction, learning materials, and full boarding while school is in session.

Enrolment fee	CHF 600	This is a non-refundable one-time payment. Payable upon enrolment.
Capital Building Fund fee	CHF 3 500	This is a non-refundable one-time payment.
Boarding fee	CHF 65 580	Pre-IB course grade 9 and grade 10 per year

Includes	Courses and classroom instruction. Tuition in all school-offered subject courses. Cost of all course books and materials. Shuttle bus to and from school. Use of a school computer. Career and university counselling, CAS programme, homework assistance and study hour supervision. WiFi and internet access. City travel pass (for individual travel to and from school). Double occupancy room. Boarding housing: supervision, accommodation and meals (3 x day) for 37 teaching weeks of school and for winter break (1 week Feb = internship week). Boarding trips and excursions.	
Excludes	IB examination fees and other external organisational services of the IB Programme. Pamoja and Langford online courses. Private tuition or coaching. Musical instrument lessons. Private sports lessons. Liability, accident & medical insurance. Travel costs for personal reasons, bus/train tickets. Stay in the Boarding house during Holidays (autumn, Christmas, spring, summer). Personal shopping, theatre, cinemas, concerts, personal restaurant visits, personal sports/club memberships. Travel insurance for trips and excursions. Health and liability insurance. Cost of medical care and medication. Personal mobile phone costs. Rental or purchase of ski or other sports equipment. Cost of Swiss resident permit.	

All school and boarding fees are payable in Swiss francs, and any exchange rate losses are the responsibility of the family.

For students holding residency in countries not part of the EU or EFTA a student visa is necessary. As part of the visa requirements, the yearly school and boarding fees have to be paid in advance. A confirmation of school fee payment is required as part of the documentation needed for visa applications. The school will send an invoice once the enrolment is completed. This invoice must be paid prior to the visa application. For students who do not require a visa, the ISSH Financial and General Regulations apply as outlined in the enrolment form.
